There will be approximately 28,000 students starting secondary school across our state next year, compared to 14,000 in previous years.


That's twice as many young people, and their carers, navigating the roads around new school environments.

Pedestrian safety is always a concern at the start of a new school year but we ask that you and your children take extra care as you make your way to your new secondary school.

Encourage students to use pedestrian crossings and to be aware of their surroundings by not using headphones or looking down at digital devices while they walk.

As drivers, parents are reminded to demonstrate safe behaviours by obeying all traffic and parking signs in school zones.
